Primary Source: 2014-2019 VCCS SEB. One FTES (full-time equivalent student) is calculated by dividing the total number of credit hours by 15. Average student load refers to the hours of course work taken by students. Full-time students are those taking 12 or more credit hours of course work. First-time students have never attended PVCC before; transfer students have attended college elsewhere and are new to PVCC; returning students have attended PVCC previously. Occupational/technical students are those enrolled in programs leading toward Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degrees or certificates; college transfer students are those enrolled in programs leading toward Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) degrees; unclassified students are not enrolled in any curricular program. Other-race students include American Indians and Alaskan natives, Asians and Pacific Islanders, Hispanics, and students who classify themselves as *other*. Off-campus students are those taking all courses at a location other than the main campus. Evening students are those taking courses only in the evening.
