



## Kathy Hudson Student Emergency Grant Fund Application

The Kathy Hudson Student Emergency Grant Fund provides quick-response emergency grants to currently enrolled students in good academic standing who are facing an unexpected short-term financial hardship due to an unforeseen emergency and/or catastrophic event that may hinder successful academic progression or cause withdrawal from the college. The goal of the fund is to help students remain enrolled in classes. Emergency funding is not intended to provide ongoing assistance for routine expenses or as a supplement for educational expenses. *Please note this is a one-time award and cannot be received again during a student's time at PVCC.*

<b>Definition</b>	<p><b>Unexpected</b> not expected, occurring without warning.</p> <p><b>Emergency</b> a sudden, generally unexpected occurrence demanding immediate action.</p> <p><b>Hardship</b> the condition of lacking necessities or comforts; privation or suffering.</p> <p><b>Catastrophic</b> a sudden event that causes great suffering or destruction.</p>
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<b>Amount of Assistance</b>	The maximum award per student is not to exceed \$750 per year. In extraordinary cases students may be awarded more than the maximum if necessary to enable a student to succeed or stay enrolled. Funds awarded through the Kathy Hudson Student Emergency Grant Fund are not loans, and do not require repayment to PVCC.
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<b>Financial Emergencies that qualify</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Temporary loss of job or income</li> <li>• Homelessness or sudden loss of housing</li> <li>• Travel expenses due to illness/death in the immediate family</li> <li>• Medical or dental emergencies</li> <li>• Loss of childcare</li> <li>• Past due utility bills/turn off notices</li> <li>• Non-routine car repair, bus passes, or other transportation needs</li> <li>• Theft of computer, books, clothing or essential items</li> </ul>
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<b>Eligibility</b>	<p>Applicants must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Have a financial hardship resulting from and due to an unforeseen emergency and/or catastrophic event (accident or other critical incident).</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Be currently enrolled for at least six credits in the semester in which the funds would apply</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Be in good academic standing</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Have no outstanding debt to PVCC</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Submit a <i>Kathy Hudson Student Emergency Grant Fund</i> application</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Include documentation to support the unforeseen emergency and/or catastrophic event</li> </ul>
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<b>Procedures</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Complete the <i>Kathy Hudson Student Emergency Grant Fund Application</i> and submit to the Financial Aid office.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Students must be prepared to advise with the Financial Aid Office before submitting the application.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> A committee will review the student's application and students will be notified of the decision by the Director of Financial aid.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Students will be notified no later than five business days after the completed application was received.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Assistance is provided in the form of a direct payment to a service provider. Funds are not provided directly to the student.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Students with unmet financial need or who have situations that will likely reoccur will be referred to community resources.</li> </ul>
